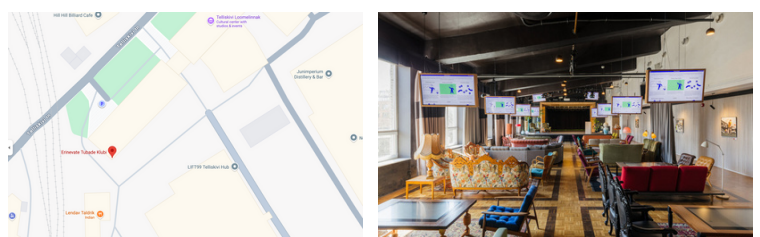

U15, U17, U19*: see IFSC Europe Rules: Youth Cup rules 2025

Adults: see IFSC Europe Rules

*U19 is allowed to choose whether they want to take part of the youth (u19) or the adult competition.

IFSC general competition rules also apply!

Qualification:

“Flash Format”:

- 6 Boulders (3+3),
- climbing time: 4 Minutes,
- rotation time 15 Seconds
- No isolation zone,
- Boulders will be demonstrated by video.

Finals:

U15, U17, U19:

- 4 boulders,
- climbing time 4 minutes,
- rotation time 15 seconds;
- quota: 10 per category.

Adults:

- 4 boulders,
- climbing time 4 minutes,
- rotation time 15 seconds;
- quota: 8 per category.

PS! Organizers have the right to:

- **merge** categories with older categories if less than 10 are registered in the category!
- **cancel semifinals** if there are less than 36 participants in the category.
